

How to Become a Flight Attendant

A Checklist

Before You Apply

- Pick an Airline
- Do you meet the requirements for this company?
- Create a resume that is tailored for the airline
- Do you speak a second language? Be sure to specify or apply for the position needing a second language

Does this airline have a base in your city? If not, are you willing to commute to work?

Phone Interview

- Go to a quiet spot where you won't be disturbed.
- Allow for 20-30 minutes for the phone interview.
- Treat this just like a face to face interview. Every question counts!
- Smile! Even though the interviewer can't see you, they can still hear a smile in your voice. Be energetic!

Prepare for the Interview

- Pack a small, professional bag or brief case. Bring pens, a note pad, breathe mint.
- Dress Professionally- Business attire is a must! Dress slacks (or skirt) with a dress shirt and business jacket if possible
- It's okay to wear an accent color, but remember less is better. *Avoid Patterns
- Bring a bottle of water- It's going to be a long day. Stay hydrated

In Person Interview

- Today is going to be a group interview along with a one-on-one interview
- Arrive on Time - Whether you drive or fly to the interview, you MUST be on time
- Be social-Don't isolate yourself. Talk to everyone you meet.
- Don't bring a book or be on your phone- Fill the free time by socializing.
- Group activities- Always include your fellow applicant. Remember they could be your co-worker later!
- Accept the Job! Congrats you got the job. Be prepared to receive an offer on the spot!
